

## GPS Tracking

Essential Sports Products (ESP) have agreed to supply and manage 24 tracking devices to be used to collate data on players during the 2017 Pacific School Games Adelaide. The data would be uploadable and be available to the athletes and coaches. ESP will be at the Games Village each evening to discuss the results. The GPS only works outdoors and only 24 can be used at any one time. It is proposed to allow teams access to the service, subject to demand, at Touch Football, Football and Hockey from Monday to Friday.

Teams should nominate that they wish to be involved by completing the details below and up to 12 athletes will be given the GPS to wear for one game. It is proposed to have at least 6 teams at each sport each day utilise this service. Allocation of the GPS trackers is purely at the discretion of ESP and will aim to ensure a mix of ages, sex, sports and country/state.
