



Risk Management Guidelines

This document has been designed to assist in the risk management of the Pacific School Games 2017 in the event of major incident.

All Team Managers and Volunteer Supervisors, **must** brief all members of their team prior to the beginning of competition each day.

The key risks identified include:

- Child Protection
- Catastrophic Sport Injury
- Catastrophic Equipment Failure
- Terrorism
- Transport Breakdown
- Extreme Weather
- Communicable Disease
- Food Poisoning
- Natural Disaster

In the case of an incident all student athletes, officials and volunteers must follow the venue emergency management plan which will be on display at each venue.

The following dot points must be adhered to:

- Follow all instructions from SAPOL, PSG personnel and venue management
- **No** comments to the media
- **No** social media posts – Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, YouTube, Snapchat
- If an evacuation has occurred all athletes must report to their Team Manager at the evacuation area
- All volunteers must report to their Supervisor at the evacuation area
- A PSG representative will update all managers on the status of the emergency once the risk has been identified and resolved
- The full safety plan is available on line and it is recommended that it is read by all volunteers
