## Accommodation options for Pacific School Games families and supporters

We are excited to welcome families and supporters of athletes to Adelaide for the 2017 Pacific School Games and want to support you the best we can.

There are number of outer suburbs that may be able to offer affordable accommodation for the duration of the Pacific School Games that are easily accessible via public transport.

### Hahndorf

Hahndorf is a small town in the Adelaide Hills region of South Australia. It is accessible from Adelaide, the South Australian capital, via the South-Eastern Freeway.

Serviced by Bus No: HL1 & HL2 buses travel to Mount Barker where you can transfer to a bus to the city. This service runs Monday to Friday.

Approximately 40 minutes by car.

### Mount Barker/Nairne

Mount Barker is approximately 33 kilometres from the Adelaide CBD and is one of the largest towns in the Adelaide Hills.

Serviced by Bus No: 864, 864F, 823, 840X, 860F and T840.

Approximately 1 hour travel time by bus or 40 minutes by car.

### Lobethal

Lobethal is located in the Adelaide Hills and is close enough to commute on public transport to the Adelaide CBD.

Serviced by Bus No: 830F

Travels through the towns of Mount Torrens, Charleston, Woodside, Oakbank, Balhannah, Verdun

You can also transfer to Mount Barker buses.

Approximately 1 ½ hours by bus or 1 hour by car.

## Noarlunga Centre/ McLaren Vale/ Maslins Beach/Aldinga Beach

The outer Southern suburbs of Adelaide offer beautiful coastline and beaches within close proximity of the wine region of McLaren Vale.

Noarlunga Centre to Adelaide route is serviced by Bus No: 721, 721F, 721X, 722, 722X

There are also connecting buses travelling through Sellicks Beach, Aldinga Beach, Maslins Beach and McLaren Vale to Noarlunga Centre where you can then transfer to a city bus.

Approximately 45 minutes by car or 1 hour 10 minutes by bus. There is also a train service from Seaford to Adelaide via Noarlunga Centre, Hallett Cove, Brighton, Oaklands & Goodwood which takes approximately 50 minutes.

## Gawler

Gawler is just over 40 kilometres north of Adelaide city centre along Main North Road. It is adjacent to the Barossa Valley.

Serviced by Train No: GAWC via Smithfield, Elizabeth, Salisbury & Mawson. Service operates 7 days including public holidays.
